Hobby Grant Application Guidelines

1. GRANT INFORMATION

St Giles Trust RLSE (RLSE) provides grants to those who are serving a custodial sentence of 24 months minimum. To qualify, applicants must have at least 24 months left to serve. Grants are capped at £20 (total) or less, depending on the type of grant requested, as detailed below.

1.1. RLSE will consider applications in respect of the following Hobby Grants:

Books	Art Materials	Painting	Paint-Brushes
Drawing	Pencils and Paper	Knitting	Sewing
Crocheting	Pencils/Art Pens	Paint by numbers	Match Stick Models
Card Making	MDF & Glue	Drawing/Sketch Pads	Any hobby/craft activities

1.2. RLSE will not consider grant applications in respect of the following:

- Applications which exceed £20
- Applicants serving a custodial sentence, less than 24 months left to serve.

1.3. All applications will need to include the following documents:

A personal statement or letter from the applicant explaining their need for a Hobby Grant.

2. APPLICATIONS, DECISION MAKING AND AWARDS

- When an application is received it will be checked for eligibility; if an application is incomplete or missing documents (as listed in section 1.3. above) a letter requesting additional information will be sent to the applicant. If we do not receive the completed/missing documents before the application submission deadline, the application will be marked as unsuccessful.
- If an applicant is ineligible for a grant, we will send the applicant a letter explaining this.
- If an application is complete (all information and documents provided) an acknowledgement letter will be sent to the applicant.
- After the application submission deadline, we allow one week to prepare all applications in readiness for the decision panel; who will meet once every 2 months, to review and score each application.
- Within 2 weeks of the panel making their decisions; applicants will be sent decision letters informing them of their application outcome.
- Successful applicants must wait a minimum of 12 months from the date of their decision letter to
 re-apply. Unsuccessful applicants must wait a minimum of 6 months from the date of their decision
 letter to reapply. Due to the high volume of applications, we receive, we are unable to provide
 feedback on individual application outcomes. Successful applicants will be sent a Hobby Grant
 cheque, made payable H M Prisons unless another payee is supplied.

2.1. Diagram of Decision-Making Process:

When we recieve a completed application, we'll send the applicant an acknowledgement letter. The letter will include information about the application process.

After the application submission deadline, all qualifying applications will be sent to the decision making panel.

The decision making panel will review & score all applications before sending the results back to the RLSE administrative team.



If the grant is awarded, a cheque made payable to HM Prisons will be sent to the applicant; 10 working days after the decision letter.



The RLSE administrative team will send the applicant a decsion letter.
